Parents/carers will:

- ✓ Support their child by encouraging a positive attitude to learning and by encouraging him/her to complete tasks given for homework.
- ✓ Attend parent/teacher interviews to exchange information and receive progress reports.
- ✓ Tell the school promptly about problems and concerns which need attention.
- ✓ Support the school in maintaining good behaviour and discipline and encouraging their child to behave well, follow instructions from staff and respect everyone in school.
